RESOLUTION NO. 2024-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER \$15,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET LIGHTING FUND

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer has determined that it is necessary to transfer certain funds from the General Fund to the Street Lighting Fund to provide the necessary revenue to pay the street lighting expenses from this fund: and

WHEREAS, the Village Council must approve certain transfers pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.14; and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer wishes to transfer funds, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.14(E), which requires a majority vote of the Village Council to authorize transfers from the General Fund to any other fund of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village is not required to seek any other approvals as may be required for other transfers of funds under Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.15 and 5705.16.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY A MINIMUM OF A MAJORITY VOTE by the Council of the Village of Antwerp, Paulding County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of Fifteen Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00) from the General Fund to the Street Lighting Fund.

Section 2. The transfer of these funds from the General Fund to the Street Lighting Fund is necessary to provide the revenue to pay the street lighting expenses of the Village of Antwerp.

Section 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowable under the laws of the State of Ohio.
