FISCAL OFFICER REPORT

Rister asked about the progress of Veteran Memorial Banners. Steiner updated council on the project and informed council that the school hopes to have more information available by the October meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Steiner asked about plans for paving projects on the streets in the village. Davis updated council on his plans for paving and possible chip seal projects moving forward.

Davis updated council on projects in the village including a possible plan to grind and repave Island St and the drive in the park. Council briefly discussed the plan and the consensus amongst council was for Davis to move forward with the paving project inside the park. Davis also updated council on plans for Shaffer Road, as well as his upcoming meeting on October 9th to seek funding opportunities for the new water treatment plant.

Mayor Reeb informed council that she was appointing a new member to the Zoning Appeals Board to take the place of a member who had resigned his position. Reeb was appointing Jeff Rhonehouse to serve on the board.

Reeb gave the mayor's report. The Village received \$2886.00, the County Indigent Driver Fund received \$39.00, and the State of Ohio received \$975 for a grand total amount collected through Mayor's Court of \$3900.00.
